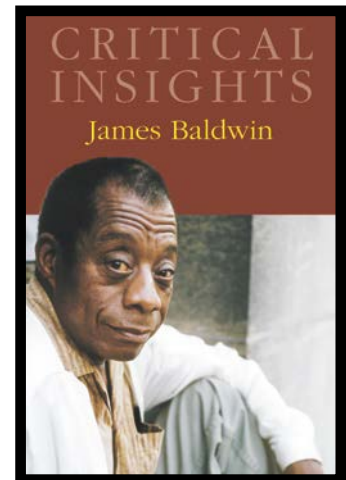


Critical Insights: James Baldwin
